GRANTS FOR INSTRUCTION

BE SPECIFIC:

- * If you need things to accomplish your idea, tell us exactly what you have in mind and how it will help you reach your goal:
 - * What kind of materials?
 - * What series of literature?
 - * What destination(s)?
 - * What kind of equipment?

PREPARE A REALISTIC BUDGET FOR YOUR IDEA

- * Do your homework on proposal.
- * Get the best estimates you can on what ideas will cost.
- Provide clarity of costs.
- * Be sure your idea is *not* something:
 - * The Board of Education will fund.
 - * Your school budget covers.
 - Covered by professional learning.

SELECT WHICH GRANT FOR WHICH YOU WILL APPLY

Pay attention to the purpose of each grant and make sure that your application fits that purpose:

FOCUS ON CHILDREN AND YOUTH

- * How will your ideas engage students with interesting, challenging and satisfying work?
- * It is not necessary to serve a large number of children to have a good proposal.
- * It helps to show what group(s) may benefit

GIVE YOUR PROJECT A SHORT, EASY-TO-IDENTIFY TITLE

A title that quickly summarizes your idea helps the Selection Committee. It also helps focus on the purpose of your project.
